PRESS RELEASE

01/02/10 @ 1505 HRS - Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a three car personal injury accident at the intersection of State Route 96 and Whiskey Hill Rd. The accident occurred when J.R. Robbins, age 19, 157 Waterloo St Clyde NY was traveling southbound on Whiskey Hill Rd approaching the intersection of State Route 96, in his 1996 Pontiac Bonneville. Robbins, neglected to stop for the stop sign driving through the intersection striking a 2009 Mercury Marquis which was operated by Peter F. Moliterno, age 50, 4818 West Seminary Avenue, Richmond, VA who was traveling southeast on State Route 96. Moliterno's vehicle continued through the intersection and then off the south side of the highway. After striking Moliterno's vehicle, the Robbins vehicle then struck a 1997 Chevrolet-Blazer being operated by Susan D. Archibald, age 50, 3253 E Sherman Hollow, Penn Yan, New York which was stopped at the stop sign on the south side of the intersection. Archibald and her passenger 8 year old Mercedes Strickland, 34 Harpending Avenue, Dundee, New York as well as Peter Moliterno were all uninjured in the collision. J.R. Robbins suffered only minor injuries and was transported by a third un-involved party to Geneva General Hospital for further evaluation after a check over by North Seneca Ambulance at the scene. Robbins reported having minor neck pain. Both Robbins and Moliterno's vehicles were heavily damaged and were towed from the scene. Archibald's vehicle was driven from the scene. Deputies were also assisted on scene by Border City Fire Department. Robbins was issued a traffic ticket for unreasonable speed for road conditions and is scheduled to appear in the Town of Waterloo Court at a later date to answer the charge.
