PRESS RELEASE

01/16/2010 – Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Joshua M. Dube, age 21, and Zachary A. Dube, age 17, both of 616 Mason St., Newark, New York. Joshua M. Dube was charged with Petit Larceny, Disorderly Conduct and Attempted Assault in the Third Degree. The Petit Larceny arrest occurred after an incident which occurred at a Town of Seneca Falls business where Joshua Dube allegedly stole two video DVD's from the business valued at approximately \$40.00. Joshua Dube was charged with Disorderly Conduct and Attempted Assault at the same location after he allegedly physically attacked an employee of the business when the employee questioned him about the stolen property. Joshua Dube was arraigned before Junius Town Court's Justice Laird at which time he was remanded to the Seneca County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$750.00 cash bail, he is scheduled to appear in the Town of Seneca Falls Court on January 21st 2010 at 10:00 am to answer the charge.

Joshua Dube's brother Zachary Dube was charged at the same Town of Seneca Falls business with Petit Larceny after it was discovered during the initial investigation that he had allegedly stole a video DVD also which was valued at \$13.00. Zachary Dube was released on an appearance ticket and is scheduled to appear before Seneca Falls Town Court on February 11th 2010 at 10:00 am to answer the charge.
