## **PRESS RELEASE**

02/16/2010 at 1542HRS - Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies investigated a three car motor vehicle accident that occurred on State Route 5 and Packwood Rd. A vehicle driven by Amber M. Greer, age 19, 2149 Route 5, Seneca Falls, New York was eastbound when she ran into the back of a vehicle driven by Donna M. Cote, age 34, 13 VanRensaleer Street, Lot 10, Seneca Fall, New York. Cote was waiting at the intersection to make a left hand turn. Her vehicle was struck from behind and went into the west bound lane of on-coming traffic and struck a vehicle driven by Shauna C. Riccione, age 38, 920 Whiskey Hill Road, Waterloo, New York. All three vehicles had to be towed from the scene. Greer and a passenger in her vehicle Tina L. Ronzo, age 19, 13700 Route 31, Savannah, New York were both transported to Geneva General Hospital by North Seneca Ambulance for chest and neck pain. A third passenger in Greer's vehicle was not injured. Cote and a passenger in her vehicle were not injured. Riccione was treated at the scene by North Seneca Ambulance and transported to Geneva General Hospital by personal transportation for neck pain. Border City Fire Department also responded to the scene. Greer was ticketed for following too close. The accident was caused by Greer when she looked away from the road to change music on an ipod
