## **PRESS RELEASE**

SCSO Activity 08/03-06/2010

08/06/2010 @ 0230 HRS - Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Jennifer M. Flowers, age 36, 348 Bostwick Road, in the Town of Junius for Driving While Intoxicated – Drugs, Aggravated Unlicensed Operation in the Third Degree and Moving for lane unsafely. Flowers is scheduled to appear in Town of Junius Court on 08/19/2010 to answer the charges.

08/05/2010 – Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Thomas J. Nastvogel, 20, no permanent address, on charges of Possession of a Loaded Firearm in a Motor Vehicle and two counts of Menacing in the second degree. It is alleged that Nastvogel was involved in a dispute with two people on Sessler Drive in the Town of Waterloo. During the dispute, Nastvogel allegedly pointed a shotgun at the victims. The victims ran from Nastvogel and were able to get away from him safely. Sheriff's Deputies arrived on scene and found Nastvogel standing in the street. Upon further investigation, it was discovered that Nastvogel had a loaded 12 gauge shotgun in his vehicle which was parked on Sessler Drive. Nastvogel was taken into custody without incident. Nastvogel was arraigned in the Waterloo Town Court and remanded to the Seneca County Correctional Facility on \$10,000 cash bail/\$20,000 secured bond. Nastvogel is to reappear in the Waterloo Town Court on August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at 1pm. The New York State Police and the Geneva Police Department assisted at the scene.

08/05/2010 – Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies arrested David M. Bird, age 43, of 5766 Route 96, Romulus, NY Bird was charged with Driving While Intoxicated and Operating Out of Class. The charges stem from an accident Bird was involved in on State Route 96 in the Town of Romulus where he lost control of a motorcycle causing him to leave the west side of the roadway where he crashed the motorcycle into the ditch. Bird did not have a license to operate the motorcycle. Bird suffered injuries to his left leg and right shoulder and was transported by South Seneca Ambulance to Geneva General Hospital where he was treated for his injuries. Bird is scheduled to appear in the Romulus Town Court on October 1<sup>st</sup> 2010 to answer the charges.

08/05/2010 – Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Walter A. Flower, age 53, of 5535 Route 96, Lot 21, Romulus, New York. Flower was charged with Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Unlawful Imprisonment in the Second Degree and Harassment in the Second Degree. The charges stem from a domestic incident where it is alleged that Flower started a physical fight with a female in front of a 10 year old child. It is alleged that during the fight Flower physically restrained the female from calling 911 and from leaving the residence. Flower was arraigned in the Town of Varick Court and remanded to the Seneca County Correctional Facility in lieu of \$1,000 cash bail or \$2500 Bond. Flower is to reappear 8/25/10 at 7:30 pm. in Varick Town court

08/05/2010 – Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Robert F. Tayne, 54, of 2429 Route 89, Seneca Falls, New York, on charges of Unlawful Imprisonment in the second degree and Harassment in the second degree. The charges stem from a domestic incident that occurred at a Town of Seneca Falls residence on 08-01-10. It is alleged that Tayne struck a female victim during a domestic dispute and held her down and attempted to choke her. Tayne was arraigned in the Seneca Falls Town Court and released on his own recognizance. Tayne is to reappear in the Seneca Falls Town Court on August 11<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at 9am. An order of protection was issued on behalf of the victim.

08/05/2010 – Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Jonathan H. Ferguson, age 21, 1272 Norwood Drive, Lockport N.Y., for Aggravated Unlicensed Operation in the Third Degree. The arrest stems from a traffic stop where DMV records showed that Ferguson had a suspended drivers license. Ferguson was issued appearance tickets for the Town of Covert Court and scheduled to appear on 9/13/10 at 10am to answer the charge.

08/04/2010 – Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies investigated a personal injury auto accident on Swick Road in the Town of Romulus. A mini van being driven by Cindy Walborn age 53 of 1470 State Route 336 Lot#2 was eastbound on Swick Road when she left the south side of the road striking a ditch then coming to rest after striking a telephone pole. The telephone pole was snapped in half at the base and Walborn was trapped in the vehicle. A witness to the accident, William J. Irwin from Lodi helped assist 4 small children ages 1,7,8,and 9 out of the van. Firefighters from Romulus and Ovid responded to the scene and extricated the driver who was trapped in the vehicle for about 45 minutes. The children were all treated at the scene for minor injuries and transported to Cayuga Medical Center by Ambulances from South Seneca and Trumansburg Fire Department. Walborn and a 5th passenger Shane W. Walborn age 26 of the same address were also treated at the scene and transported to Cayuga Medical Center as well. The vehicle was heavily damaged and had to be towed from the scene.

08/03/2010 – Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Jennifer L. Heidemann, age 23, 1326 West Townline Road, Phelps, New York on a Bench Warrant issued out of the Town of Seneca Falls Court for failure to comply with conditions of pre trial release. Heidemann was arraigned at the Town of Seneca Falls Court and was remanded to the Seneca County Jail with no bail. Heidemann is to reappear before the Town of Seneca Falls Court on August 13th, 2010 at 2:00pm for further action.

08/03/2010 – Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Jacob M. Dixon, age 19, 2551 Brewer Road, Waterloo, N.Y. Dixon was charged with Disorderly Conduct following an incident where Dixon was allegedly causing a road hazard by walking down the center of State Route 414 in the Town of Tyre. Sheriff's Deputies were dispatched to check the area following multiple complaints on the subject. Dixon is scheduled to appear before the Town of Tyre Court on September 7th 2010 at 5:00 pm to answer the charges.
