PRESS RELEASE

12/05/2010 - @ 1645 HRS – Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a one-car personal injury motor vehicle accident on Route 89, North of Cemetery Road in the Town of Fayette. A vehicle being operated by Jacqueline A. Teeter, 23, of 4974 Route in Romulus, New York, was northbound on Route 89 when she lost control due to slippery road conditions. The vehicle went off the roadway and struck a utility pole. Teeter complained of abdominal pain and was transported to Geneva General Hospital by South Seneca Ambulance. The Canoga Fire Department and Red Jacket Fire Department also responded to the scene. The vehicle was demolished and was towed from the scene.

12/05/2010 @ 0035 HRS – Seneca County Sheriff Deputies arrested Robert A. Goodell, age 31, and Lorraine A. Goodell, age 36, of 1773 North Road, Waterloo, N.Y., on Endangering the Welfare of a Child charges. The charges stem from a physical domestic dispute between the Goodell's in the presence of two children ages 10 and 12. Waterloo PD and Sheriff's Deputies responded to the call. Robert and Lorraine Goodell were both issued appearance tickets for the Town of Waterloo Court. They are to appear on 1/4/11 at 1pm to answer the Sheriff's Office charges.

12/04/2010 - @ 2256 HRS – Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Sterling R. Peters, age 46, of 2500 Edwards Rd, Waterloo, N.Y.. Peters was charged with Harassment in the second degree following an incident in the Town of Waterloo, where he allegedly shoved a 49 year old female. Peters was issued an appearance ticket for the charge and released. Peters is scheduled to appear in the Town of Waterloo Court before the Honorable Justice R. Marsh on December 14th 2010 to answer the charge.

12/04/2010 @ 2137 HRS – Seneca County Sheriff's Deputies responded to Balsley Rd in the Town of Seneca Falls for the report of a two car personal injury motor vehicle accident. Desmond A Lawton , 18, of Waterloo, N.Y., was east bound on Balsley Rd when a west bound vehicle being operated by Theresa Diaz, 18, of Waterloo, N.Y., lost control and slid into Lawton's lane. Lawton attempted to avoid Diaz but was unable to and was struck head on by Diaz. Lawton's vehicle was spun around and came to rest in the middle of the road. Diaz's vehicle left the south side of the road and overturned coming to rest in the ditch. Diaz was transported to Geneva General Hospital with a possible concussion. Lawton was uninjured; however a passenger in Lawton's vehicle, Bethany Destefano, 18, of Seneca Falls, N.Y., was transported to Geneva General Hospital with pain in her abdomen and ribs. Both vehicles suffered extensive damage and were towed from the scene.

12/04/2010 @ 0032 HRS – Seneca County Sheriff Deputies investigated a personal injury motor vehicle accident on Co. Rd. 139 in Ovid, N.Y. Injured in the accident was the driver William H. Staples, 61, of 2063 Seneca Street, Ovid, N.Y., and the passenger Donna L. Stone, 50, of 25 Peterman Rd. Apt. B2 Seneca Falls. Staples was operating a Ford Ranger pick up truck east on Co. Rd. 139 on icy roads when the vehicle entered the ditch on the south side of the road and overturned. Both occupants were extricated by Ovid F.D. Staples and Stone were transported by South Seneca Ambulance to Geneva General Hospital for minor complaints of pain.
